

ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

Committee policy

The committee shall be headed by head of the institution and shall consist of representatives of faculty members, parents, students, non teaching staff, local area sub inspector, lawyer and a social worker. It shall take the recommendation of the anti ragging squad and take appropriate decisions regarding the measures of preventing ragging in the college.

The committee shall also have a anti ragging squad nominated by the principal consisting of members representating various departments in the college.

The committee shall also have a monitoring cell on ragging to coordinate the activities of anti ragging committee and anti ragging squad. It shall also consist of members from all varied departments in the institution.

Plan of action

At the beginning of each academic year the principals shall submit weekly reports to the vice chancellor for the first three months and then monthly reports to the authorities in the university. The committee shall encourage student interaction by organizing fresher's day and orientation day.

The anti ragging squad is expected to keep vigil on hostels ,playgrounds, canteens and any other potential areas of ragging .the squad plans and executes various surprise visits to both ladies and gents hostel.

The monitoring cell helps in coordinating the efforts of these two bodies and is expected to conduct various counseling sessions, orientation programmes in the college.
